PASTOR'S CORNER

Proverbs 1:7, "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge..." We live in a world today where knowledge has dramatically increased over the past 100 years. To think of technology advancements in the recent generations is simply amazing, and to see children learning in elementary school what used to take until high school to learn is incredible. This leads me to this thought: How can we have access to so much knowledge today, but yet also live in the most wicked generation? The answer is found in the TEXT verse above. *The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge.* People are learning about everything else except for fearing the LORD. Man thinks that he is the smartest he has ever been, but in reality, we could argue that man is the dumbest he has ever been. Why? Because every generation gets farther and farther away from the truth found in God's Word. The advancements of knowledge may be amazing, but if they have caused our society to grow further away from God, what is the benefit from it? To quote the founder of our Dictionary, Noah Webster, "Education is useless without the Bible." We are truly in the last days, where men are *ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth* (2 Tim. 3:7). It is sad that children today are being educated in everything else other than the most important thing they could be educated in – *the fear of the LORD!* May God have mercy on us!
