PASTOR'S CORNER

Exodus 40:38, *"For the cloud of the LORD was upon the tabernacle by day, and fire was on it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel, throughout all their journeys."*

The presence of the LORD never departed from the children of Israel: it was with them *throughout all their journeys*. When the cloud moved, they moved, and when the cloud didn't move, they didn't move. Just as the presence of the LORD led them back then, He desires to lead His people in the same way today. Too often in our Christian lives we tend to put the cart in front of the horse, and end up in situations we should have never been in to begin with. We are such an impatient generation and want everything right now, but we must wait upon the LORD to move us, and sometimes that means to stand still and let God move. Back in Chapter 33, the LORD told Moses that His presence would go with them. Moses replied, *If thy presence go not with me, carry us not up hence*. In other words, if the LORD isn't going to be the leader, then he didn't want to go anywhere! We ought to have the same mentality as Christians today. AMEN.
