PASTOR'S CORNER

Exodus 34:35, *"And the children of Israel saw the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses' face shone: and Moses put the vail upon his face again, until he went in to speak with him."*

2 Corinthians 3:7-8, *"But if the ministration of death, written and engraven in stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not stedfastly behold the face of Moses for the glory of his countenance; which glory was to be done away: How shall not the ministration of the spirit be rather glorious?"*

In other words, if being in the presence of God in the Old Testament was so good, that it caused Moses face to shine, HOW MUCH MORE shall the child of God in this Dispensation of Grace, who has the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, be able to shine?
