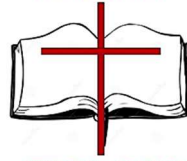

Ecclesiastes 12:13-14, "Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil."

As Solomon was closing this book of wisdom as an old man while reflecting on his life, he pens down these final two verses under the inspiration of the Holy Ghost. The *conclusion of the whole matter* in respect of how we should each live our lives is simply to ***Fear God, and keep his commandments***.
