**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**Psalm 112:7**, "He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD."

This Psalm is about the blessed man who fears the Lord. To fear the Lord means to have a reverential trust, with hatred of evil. To trust in the Lord is to take refuge in His promises; to lean on Him during difficult times; to know that He is in control, and that *all things work together for good to them that love God* (Romans 8:28). This verse is teaching us that if we are in the center of God's Will, then our heart will be *fixed, trusting in the Lord*, even when we receive bad news. Fixed means to be firmly established. As a Christian grows in his relationship with the Lord, his faith will begin to grow. As the trials and tribulations come, and as God sees the Christian through them all, we begin to trust in the Lord more. We can look back on our lives and see the Hand of God moving, even when we didn't realize He was moving! Not only that, but we can see many biblical examples all throughout the Scriptures of God showing up in the right place at the right time. Is your heart fixed today? Is your faith in the Lord firmly established? When evil tidings come your way, do you begin to question God, or do you fully trust God? Do you begin to worry, or do you just praise Him anyway, knowing that He is still in control? *My heart is fixed, O God, my heart is fixed: I will sing and give praise* (Psalm 57:7). AMEN!
