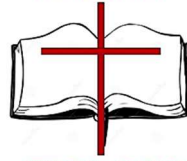

PASTOR'S CORNER

2 Corinthians 7:10, "For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death."

There is a difference in godly sorrow and sorrow. It is one thing to be sorry for what you've done, but it is another thing to be sorrowful toward God for what you've done. It is when a sinner realizes that they have sinned against God that godly sorrow will come, which will work them toward repentance and salvation. There have been many people sorry because they got caught or because of the consequences that they had to face, but just being sorry doesn't produce salvation. **Repentance is a change of mind about sin that leads to a changed life.** It is not a prayer that saves someone, but the decision of repentance and accepting God's terms through Jesus Christ for salvation. In order to be saved, you must repent! You must change your mind about sin, and realize that you have sinned, and trust Christ as your Saviour, Who will come into your heart and give you the power to overcome the temptation to sin. There have been many false professions of faith by people who have simply repeated a prayer, but they never truly repented toward God. We must be sure to preach and teach that repentance is necessary for salvation! AMEN!
