PASTOR'S CORNER

1 Corinthians 10:31, *"Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God."*

Instead of asking ourselves, "Is this a sin?" we need to ask ourselves, "Will this thing that I am about to do bring glory to God, or will it hurt my testimony and hinder my witness to someone?" That will answer many questions about tattoos, excessive piercings, going to bars, smoking cigarettes, etc... if something you are doing or having done will not bring honor and glory to God, then it is much better for you that you don't do it... smoking cigarettes won't send you to hell, but it will sure make you smell like hell, and it will hinder your Christian witness... getting a tattoo won't send you to hell, but it will make you look like the world and it will damage your testimony. We should stop justifying our decisions and looking for a way out of conviction over something, and start praying about every decision we make, with this verse in mind. Our main goal as a Christian ought to be for our life to bring glory and honor to the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ! Amen.
