PASTOR'S CORNER

2 Corinthians 9:6-8, "But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully. Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work:"

You can't out-give God! The more you give, the more you'll receive, if you are giving cheerfully from your heart, not expecting anything in return, and not expecting recognition or praise of man. God is able to make ALL grace abound... ALWAYS... ALL sufficiency in ALL things... EVERY good work. Five times God says ALL in one verse. He has a storehouse full of ALL blessings available for us, but in order to receive them, we must be willing to give. And the more you give, the more you'll get.
