PASTOR'S CORNER

Colossians 3:13, "Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye."

It amazes me that Christians have such a hard time forgiving one another. I have wondered how many unsaved people have never once attended church in their adulthood due to many church members being full of bitterness, pride, and unforgiveness in their heart. HAVE WE FORGOTTEN what Jesus Christ forgave us for? And if we even think for one second that we didn't need much forgiveness, then we need to take a good look at CALVARY once again. No matter how small you think your past sins were, Jesus still had to die for them!
