**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**Psalm 119:126**, "It is time for thee, LORD, to work: for they have made void thy law."

This is a wonderful prayer to pray every single time after you have witnessed to someone who rejected the Gospel or refused to listen to what you had to say. **It is time for thee, LORD, to work: for they have made void thy law.** The two things that every Christian can do is to be a witness, and to pray not just before witnessing, but pray afterwards that God would work in their hearts and that the seeds that were sown would be watered by another! Rather than getting discouraged, remember that they aren't rejecting you, they are rejected the Lord; instead of remaining down in spirit, pray instead that the Lord would go to work on their hearts - that the Holy Ghost would get them under old-time conviction, and take away their appetite, their sleep, whatever it takes to get their attention! Let the words of this verse ring in your hearts, and meditate upon them after you have been obedient to the Lord in witnessing! **AMEN**
