PASTOR'S CORNER

Daniel 6:10, "Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime."

Daniel did not compromise his personal prayer life even though the current circumstances were tempting for him to quit praying for thirty days. Daniel had purposed in his heart 70 years prior to this text that he would not defile himself (Dan. 1:8). His life of faithfulness to God was a direct result of his personal prayer life and intimate relationship with the Lord. How many times have we rushed through the day, the week, or even a full month without really praying and getting in touch with God because we are too busy? It could have cost Daniel his life, but he was going to be faithful to God no matter what happened to him. He was much like the Apostle Paul, who desired for Christ to be magnified in his body, whether it be by life, or by death (Phi. 1:20). Have you allowed things in your life to replace your alone time with God? Say, have you ever even had a personal prayer life where you discipline yourself to make time for the Lord regardless of your daily schedule? How we need to be more like Daniel and pray three times a day no matter what the circumstances are all around us! AMEN.
